

# **LHS TOUCHDOWN CLUB**

**April 8, 2019**

The LHS Touchdown Club met Monday night, April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 7pm in the team room of the field house at Loganville High School.

President Cory Lowe was absent so the meeting was called to order by Vice-President Brandon Cordell. Secretary Jo Mason said that the minutes from the March meeting had been posted. ## **NEW BUSINESS**

Coach Humphreys then shared a few things. First, was the reminder of our physical night which will be April 16, 2019 from 5-6pm in the LHS BAND HALLWAY. The cost is \$20 and the physical will be good for one year and will be good for all sports and the High School and Middle School as well . Coach said that next week will begin the preparation for spring practice. Offensive Meetings will be April 16, 17, and 18 for V/JV/9<sup>th</sup> grade. These will be after school. Rising freshman will ride the bus after school to the high school just as they did for weight training. The following week April 23, 24, and 25<sup>th</sup> will be the defensive meetings. Returning players will be issued their equipment during second period weight training the week of April 22<sup>nd</sup> when they turn in the emails for the letter writing campaign that we are doing for a fundraiser. Each player is required to turn in 20 emails. Rising freshman and others will be issued equipment after school the week of April 29<sup>th</sup>. Rising freshman will also be given a Baseline Concussion Test at LHS after the equipment is passed out. Spring Practice will be in full swing starting May 6<sup>th</sup> and will conclude with our RED WHITE GAME

Friday evening May 17. Be watching emails for information regarding the Hot Dog supper which follows the game on the 17<sup>th</sup>.

Christie Screws , head of membership then stated that we would be passing out our raffle tickets at the physical night and our pancake breakfast tickets. Each player this year will be selling 20 raffle tickets. A post- dated check will be taken that night for \$200 until the raffle ticket money is turned back in. Additional tickets can be sold with 100% going to your player's fee for the year.

Katie Farmer reminded everyone of the pancake breakfast dates. The Jr's and Seniors will be having their breakfast on May 18<sup>th</sup>, the Saturday morning after the Red White Game and the Freshmen and Sophomores will have their breakfast on August 17<sup>th</sup>. It was split this way due to seating limitations at Applebees. Each player will be asked to sell 8 tickets at \$7.00 each. We will get \$5.00 for each ticket sold. Our players will serve us. Katie also reminded everyone of the advertising opportunities in order to earn the player fees. Forms are posted on the web site .

Jo Mason stated that this year we are in the process of working on a couple of things. First Billi Akins has asked to not do spirit wear next year. She did an awesome job but honestly had a hard time lining up volunteers to work the games and really just needs a break. We are tossing around the idea of having an online store which will alleviate the need for setting up at games, volunteers etc... This is still in the works and being discussed. Also still being discussed is our concession stand. Janelle Redding was in charge last year and did a good job.

However, this is a big undertaking for anyone and we also had a hard time lining up parents to work on game nights. Most weeks this concession stand was running 3 nights a week when the middle school played at home and we were just having to use too many students or pay outside sources to come in. Churches were great to offer help but we still wanted to give them something for their time and trouble. This too is being looked at to see how we can improve our sales, staffing ..etc. There will be more information to follow on this.

Brandon Cordell asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. A motion was made by Janelle Redding and a second was made by Jerry Daniel. Meeting was adjourned.
